# **FUNCTION READING (DIGITAL)**

Normal Display:

Hour, minutes, seconds and day of the week

Push D: For alarm time Push B: For mode

Push C: For month and date

### SETTING THE ANALOG WATCH TIME

Pull the crown out to the first click and set the time. When finished push the crown in.

#### NORMAL TIME AND DATE SETTING

In normal time mode push B three times to switch to normal time and date setting. (The day "Tue" should be flashing)

Push **D** to select the flashing digits of seconds, minutes, hours, day, month.

Push **C** to advance the respective digits. Select 12/24 hours mode by advancing the hour digits until AM or PM will be shown in the display for 12 hours mode or none of AM/PM will be shown. (24 hours mode)

Push B to return to normal time.

#### CHIME ON/OFF

Hold **D**, push **B** in normal time mode. All day names appear = chime ON, all day names disappeared = chime OFF.



## **ALARM ON/OFF**

Hold D, push C in normal time mode. If sound icon appears = alarm ON, if sound icon disappears = alarm OFF.


### SETTING THE ALARM

In normal time mode push B twice to switch to alarm time setting. Note: You can only set the alarm to go off on a specific day. If set, the alarm will chime at the same time everyday. After you set the alarm to the time you want and the alarm starts to chime, push **D** to stop alarm chime sound.

Push **D** to switch between hours and minutes.

Push C to advance the respective digits.

Push **B** again to return to normal time.



## STOP WATCH FUNCTION

Push **B** once when in normal time mode to switch to stopwatch mode.

Push **C** for start/stop function.

Push **D** while counting for lap (split) time and push **D** again to resume counting.

Push C to stop and D to clear when stopped counting to reset to zero.

#### CARE AND FEEDING

Avoid exposing your watch to water, steam, or other forms of moisture if it is non-water-resistant. If the crystal/lens becomes damaged, have it replaced at once to avoid damage to the module. When your battery is depleted, have it replaced promptly.

### BATTERY REPLACEMENT

When readout becomes dim, or there is no display, it is time to replace the battery. Replace with: UCC 392, Renata 2 or Toshiba LR41 or equivalent.

GuardDog Watch and Clock, LLC strongly recommend taking your watch to a local watch retailer, jeweler or watch repair service to have the battery replaced. Opening the case back without specialty tools and expertise is likely to result in damage.
